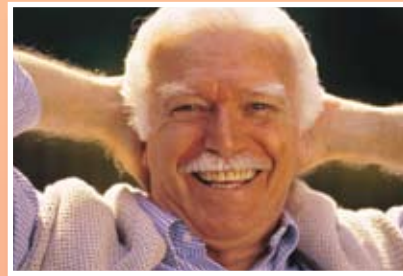

In-Home Services

These services literally provide a life line to Sublette County seniors and others who need help or cannot independently perform normal daily living tasks.

Community Based In-Home Services



This program is managed by the State of Wyoming Department of Health, Aging Division. It provides personal care and homemaking services to Sublette County seniors 60 years of age or over, their spouses, and some disabled individuals 18 years of age or over.

Potentially eligible individuals participate in a needs assessment to determine if they qualify. The assessment will also be used to develop her or his care plan.

SERVICES THAT MAY BE INCLUDED IN THE IN-HOME CARE PLAN:

Homemaking

- Light housework
- Shopping
- Managing money
- Meal preparation
- Use of telephone or computer
- Correspondence

Personal Care

- Bathing
- Dressing
- Hair care
- Walking
- Personal hygiene

Other Services

- Minor home modification
- Temporary respite
- Assistance with emergency electronic warning devices or "life lines."

Rendezvous Pointe's fees for these services is based on the ability to pay.

Our In-Home Services program has an Admission and Waiting List Policy and a Discharge Policy. They are available upon request and will be given to each potentially eligible client.

Lending Closet

Beyond In-Home Services, Rendezvous Pointe offers a lending closet for anyone in temporary need whether due to an accident, surgery or other infirmity. Among other items, the Closet includes walkers, canes, crutches, shower and bath benches, pill boxes, toilet seat risers, wheelchairs, electric wheelchairs, and wheelchair ramps.
